

Minimum Connection Time:

MCT is as per airline rules. Please allow enough time for passengers to go between the airplane and the train station. Connection time is included from airport to train station in GDS.

Eligibility:

Infants 2 years of age and under ride free without a ticket if no seat is required. The infant must be accompanied on all services in the same compartment by an adult.

Child fare is not available.

No group bookings allowed.

No unaccompanied minors permitted.

No applicable discounts for airline staff.

Refunds are according to Airline Tariff Rules.

Stopovers are not permitted.





Services:

Passengers can be booked into Economy Class (Y).

Korail operates two types of high-speed trains: the KTX and the KTX-Sancheon. The KTX-Sancheon boasts upgraded seats and individual power outlets. Both offer spacious seating, onboard restrooms, and vending machines. Wi-Fi is available, with complimentary or paid options depending on the class.






Figure 3: KTX-Sancheon

Check-in Process:

Check-in is essential to ensure a smooth travel experience.

Passengers must check-in to retrieve their actual travel documents. Check-in can be done beginning 72-hours prior to departure. Check-in is done on https://check-in.accesrail.com/#/step1 (See Figure 5) using the passenger's name as it appears in the booking and either the booking reference or 13-digit ticket number.

There is no through check-in for passengers or baggage






Figure 6: Sample Boarding Pass

When the passenger checks-in they will receive their train ticket to or from Seoul station (See Figure 6).




Figure 7: AREX Boarding Pass

For connecting services between Incheon Airport and Seoul Station, a second ticket for the AREX Express Train is issued and provided at check-in for that specific service (See Figure 7).

Passengers can then save their ticket to their device and/or print it.


Figure 8: Airport Transfer Information Page

Interline passengers with a service in/out of Incheon Airport will be provided with an information page at the time of check-in to assist the passenger on how to proceed between the airport and train station (See Figure 8).

Airport Transfers:

Bookings for journeys between Incheon Airport and destinations within South Korea will require a change of train at Seoul Station. The AREX Express service between Incheon Airport and Seoul Station will be booked together with the connecting service and the passenger will receive two tickets, one for the AREX Express Train and one for the high-speed Korail service out of Seoul Station.

Luggage:

Korail luggage rules apply. It is the passenger's responsibility to collect their checked bags from the airport and carry them to their respective train and vice-versa. Customer is responsible for their own baggage during the train journey.

On-board Meals:

There are no on-board meals in KTX trains, as the trains are optimized for high capacity. Passengers can buy food and drinks on board from vending machines.

Mobility Assistance:

Mobility assistance for Korail must be requested in advance. Mobility assistance requests for passengers can be made by calling (82) 1544-7788 + 7.

Delays:

In case of train delays, passengers must contact the airline to be re-assigned to the next available flight.

KTX train tickets are valid on the date and time found on the ticket.

In case of flight delays, Korail will provide a seat (if possible) or standing room availability to accommodate the passenger on the next available train.





SSR Message:

Please note that the SSR message will contain check-in information.

FAQ:

1. Do passengers have to check-in?

Yes, passengers must check-in to retrieve their actual travel documents. If passengers do not check-in they may not be let onto the train. The check-in site is https://check-in.accesrail.com/#/step1

2. Is Korail a TRN or BUS?

Korail is a Train (TRN) service.

3. How early should I arrive at the train station?

Korail recommends arriving at the train station at least 15 minutes prior to departure.

4. How are refunds handled?

Refunds are according to tariff rules.
